



FUNDRAISING AT MFS 2009-10

Each year, MFS and the MFS Parents Association invite participation in a number of fundraising events and campaigns that achieve a variety of financial and community-building goals. We encourage 100% participation from all families in each event. Please review this sheet to consider the ways your family will choose to participate in each of the campaigns for the coming school year.

Capital Campaign **Goal: \$2,500,000 Raised to Date: \$2,294,857**

School-sponsored campaign to support the purchase and renovation of the Mira Vista site, the new, permanent location for our Elementary School Program.

Participation Opportunity: Significant one-time financial gift commensurate with each family's capabilities.

Annual Giving Campaign **Goal: 100% Participation/\$50,000**

School-sponsored campaign to bridge the gap between tuition and the total cost to educate each child. Supports teachers' benefits, classrooms and resource programs.

Participation Opportunities: Financial donation commensurate with each family's capabilities.

Spring Soiree **Goal: \$40,000**

Parents' Association sponsored community event and auction to support the Scholarship Fund, which provides financial assistance to qualifying students.

Participation Opportunities: Donate or solicit items for auction; Admission to the event (est. \$35-\$50/person); Volunteer time to help organize/manage the event.

Spaghetti Carnival (Fall Event) **Goal: 100% Participation**

Parents' Association sponsored social event for students and parents to play carnival games and enjoy a delicious spaghetti dinner and baked goods.

Participation Opportunities: Dinner at the event (est. \$15-20/person); Volunteer time to help organize/manage the event; Optional purchase of Carnival Tickets (est. to be \$20 per child).

Additional Campaigns **Goal: 100% Participation**

- E-Scrip/School Pop: No-cost fundraising through online and in-store purchases.
- Read-A-Thon: A school-wide promotion where students raise pledges for each book read.
- Additional smaller events and outreach drives throughout the year.
